



2006 TRAINING CALENDAR

Courses will be held at the FDTN Training Academy in Indianapolis.

ADVANCED RIT OPERATIONS — March 20-22, 2006 — November 13-15, 2006

This course builds on our basic course and presents students with increasingly difficult RIT operations, under live fire conditions. After reviewing basic RIT positions and assignments, students perform individual rescue and RIT skills under realistic smoke and fire conditions. Day 3 is all scenario-based. Complete RIT operations, under the most realistic conditions you will find, to rescue a firefighter. Registration: \$450.00/\$400.00 members.

FIREGROUND SEARCH OPERATIONS — May 15-17, 2006

Aggressive fireground search saves lives, the clock starts ticking before you ever arrive. The amount of time it takes to find a victim determines the victim's chances of survival. We don't get enough fires to learn effective search skills on the street — the stakes are too high. After reviewing search size-up and developing a search plan, students learn and develop solid search techniques under increasingly realistic conditions. Residential searches, multiple dwellings, commercial buildings, and more... You'll conduct searches in some of the most realistic conditions possible to develop your search skills. It's the basics skills that save lives — learn them! Registration: \$450.00/\$400.00 members.

ENGINE COMPANY OPERATIONS I — May 22-24, 2006 — November 6-8, 2006

This 3-day course is pure Engine Company Operations. A morning lecture identifies *fireground* engine company operations, including riding positions and assignments, water supply, stretching and operating the first line, the backup line, and when to use the 2½-inch line. Hands-on skill stations are conducted, under increasingly realistic conditions, to build solid engine company skills. Day 3 is all scenario-based, under live fire conditions, performing as members of an engine company. **Note: This course is run simultaneously with the Truck Company Operations course.** Registration: \$450.00/\$400.00 members.

TRUCK COMPANY OPERATIONS I — May 22-24, 2006 — November 6-8, 2006

This 3-day course is pure Truck Company Operations. A morning lecture identifies *fireground* truck company operations, including riding positions and assignments, search, ventilation, tools, and the inside and outside team concept. Hands-on skill stations are conducted, under increasingly realistic conditions, to build solid truck company skills. Day 3 is all scenario-based, under live fire conditions, performing as members of a truck company. **Note: This course is run simultaneously with the Engine Company Operations course.** Registration: \$450.00/\$400.00 members.

RAPID INTERVENTION TEAMS — April 3-5, 2006 — June 12-14, 2006 — August 14-16, 2006 — October 16-18, 2006

THIS COURSE IS A MUST HAVE FOR ALL FIREFIGHTERS! Rapid Intervention begins with PREVENTION. This course teaches rapid intervention skills in 3 stages: Firefighter Survival, Firefighter Rescue, and Rapid Intervention Team Operations. Day one is spent building prevention skills into each firefighter (and preparing them to be members of a RIT). Skills include: SCBA emergencies, MAYDAY, disorientation emergencies and emergency escape techniques. Day two is spent learning the individual techniques and skills involved in firefighter rescue. Skills include: emergency air supply, searching for a firefighter, assessing and packaging a firefighter, drags and carries, ladder rescues, rescues from entanglements, breaches, below grade, and restricted areas. Day three details the positions, assignments, and fireground operations (proactive tasks, tool use, staging) of a rapid intervention team. Skills include: performing as RIT officer, navigation/air supply, search, and packaging firefighter assigned to a RIT. Day three scenarios combine all skills learned, under realistic fireground conditions, while operating as a RIT in response to a fireground Mayday. This intense three-day course provides students with the solid foundation and skills-set needed to work as a member of a rapid intervention team on the fireground. Registration: \$450.00/\$400.00 members.

COMMANDING RIT OPERATIONS — April 5, 2006 — June 14, 2006 — August 16, 2006 — October 28, 2006

This intense one-day course is designed for anyone who may be faced with commanding a RIT or MAYDAY operation. Real-time, hands-on-training, under realistic conditions. The course provides students with a solid foundation, and the basic tools needed, to run a rapid intervention operation on the fireground. Registration: \$175.00/\$150.00 members.

RIT TRAIN-THE-TRAINER — April 3-7, 2006 — June 12-16, 2006 — August 14-18, 2006 — October 16-20, 2006

This is the most comprehensive course and instructional package available for developing, training and implementing a fire department Rapid Intervention Team program. On days one, two and three, all students participate in FDTN's intense three-day Rapid Intervention Team program with special emphasis on teaching the skills. Days four and five are spent preparing to deliver the complete program to the student's department. The course provides a complete Instructor Manual and accompanying resources for delivery back home. FIREGROUND COMPANY OFFICER — September 25-29, 2006

This is a *fireground-based* company officer course designed around Common Sense and Solid Fireground Skills! The course is for company officers and firefighters on their way to becoming a company officer. *Fireground Company Officer* is designed to build a solid and functional fireground officer — both on the fireground and back at the firehouse. Skills will focus on communication, team building, problem solving (through prevention), training, fireground officer skills and performance, the engine company officer, the truck company officer, and Basic Common Sense. It's not a textbook, or sit-on-your butt, course. This course builds and improves company officer skills through hard work and performance! It takes a lot more than being a good firefighter to be a good company officer — do you have what it takes? Registration: \$1175.00/\$1050.00 members.
